5] CONTESTANTS AGE:

A] Cadets: An athlete born in 2004, 2005, 2006 & 2007 is eligible to participate in this trials

- B] <u>Undertaking</u>: It is the responsibility of the State associations that the secondary entry must be countersigned by Parent/guardian of players.
- **6] CONTEST RULES**: The Championships will be held on the basis of JFI/IJF Contest Rules and Regulations and the Sporting Code.
- 7] **PARTICIPATIONS**: Participation through State/UTs, and only Registered players and officials will be allowed to participate.
- **8] ELIGIBILITY:** All the players must fall in the respective age Group and other rules and regulations mentioned.

9] ENTRIES:

- a. Final Entry by Name must be received by JFI office before 24th December 2022 on JFI email ifiindia@gmail.com
- b. Each State/UTs can enter many entries in each weight categories. No limit on entries.
- c. NO change or re-arrangement of players will be allowed after the entries are submitted.
- Xerox copy of the age proof of EACH competitor must be attached along with the entry form.
- e. Players and Officials must bring their latest Two passport size photographs.

10] WEIGH-IN:

- a. A player must fit into his/her weight category and cannot play in a higher or lower weight category. Each competitor shall be allowed upon the scales only once during the official weigh- in.
- b. No tolerance will be allowed either above or below the weight category.
- Weigh-in will be conducted on 27th December 2022.

d. Weigh-in schedule: Un-official weigh in : from 6.00 pm.to 6.30 pm.

Official weigh-in : from 6.30 pm.to 7.30 pm.

11] **DURATION**: All matches for Boys & Girls will be as under:

12] CONDUCT OF MATCHES:

a. Matches will be conducted on knock out cum double repechage (repechage will start quarterfinal onwards).

b. Rules pertaining to Arm Locks & Choke Locks.

Cadets: Arm locks are allowed.

Choke Locks are allowed. However, if a player gets unconscious in a bout, then the player cannot play the subsequent bout.

13] Eligibility Documents (as per the rules of Khelo India Youth Games):

Any two of the following documents shall be required for participation:

- 1. Aadhar Card or Passport
- 2. Matriculate Certificate
- Birth Certificate (issued at least 5 years ago i.e. on or before 01 January 2017 by Municipal Corporation / Gram Panchayat)
- Measures against Age Fraud: As per the Government Circular Ltr. No. F-32- 18/2009-SP-III, Dated 25/11/2009, measures against age fraud in sports, JFI have the right to take medical examination of an athlete whenever any doubt arise with regard the age of an athlete on account of his/her physical appearance, receipt of any compliant or any other valid ground. In case of such examination found positive, JFI can take the necessary action as per the clauses of Disqualification.

15] TEAM OFFICIALS:

a. Maximum number of Officials permitted is One Manager and Two Coaches for each State/UT

16] DISQUALIFICATION:

- a] In case any player fail to submit the Original documents mentioned in the above Age Proof column, he/she will be disqualified.
- b] In case of any player found over-age, he/she will be disqualified.
- c] Any player and/or official and/or team who by word, action or deed disrupts and or/interrupts the smooth and normal conduct of the Championships on or off the mat, will be liable for immediate disqualification.
- **Judogi Control**: Judogi Control will be operated with a Sokuteiki Prior to the fight. The Judogi must be IJF (International Judo Federation) or JFI approved or equivalent specifications as per the IJF Ruels.
- **INSURANCE:** Each State Association/UT must assure all responsibility of accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials during their stay. The Judo Federation of India not accept any responsibility in this regard. It is requested to make necessary insurance coverage for your team/athletes.
- **Feminity control**: A medical certificate in English/Hindi issued by qualified Gynecologist of the player state attesting the Sex and Non- pregnancy of the women player is required to be submitted by the Manager on demand.

20] JFI Registration & Entry Fee:

a. JFI Registration Fee : Players/ Officials (Per person) : Rs.200.00 b. Entry fee : Player/Athlete : Rs.500.00

The payments may be paid by Demand Draft or Cash.

21] Boarding, Lodging & Transportation:

The Boarding, Lodging, Transportation etc. are to be arranged by the individual/State/UTs. At their own cost, JFI is not responsible for the same.

Selection of Khelo India Youth Games 2022: The TOP 12 athlete/Judo player in each weight categories will be selected to participate in the 5th Edition of Khelo India Youth Games 2022, M.P., subject to the final decision of Selection Committee JFI.

23] ANTI -DOPING:

Doping test will be carried out in accordance with the rules, by the respective authorities

24] IMPORTANT COVID PROTOCOL: MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS TO PARTICIPATE

- 1] Face Mask
- 2] All the participants must frequently do hand wash with soap (at least 40-60 seconds) wherever feasible.
- 3] Self-monitoring of health by all the participants and must report to the Technical Officials in case of any illness.
- 4] Spitting in the field of play, arena are strictly prohibited
- All the participants must installed the Aarogya Setu App, and must be updated.
